

Current status of NC permits:

ACP, LLC has only ONE NC permit, the Erosion and Sediment Control permit for the bottom three counties in NC (Sampson, Cumberland, Robeson). Permits STILL not granted, despite several delays, include:

- **The 401 Water Quality Certification**, a permit saying that DEQ certifies that there will not be undue water quality impacts by construction or operation of the pipeline, has NOT been approved. DEQ has already done FIVE “additional information” requests, expected to postpone the permit consideration for a month or more.
- **The Erosion and Sedimentation Control Plan** for the 5 northern NC counties along the ACP (Northampton, Halifax, Nash, Wilson, Johnston). DEQ has sent numerous “additional information” requests.
- **The Air Quality Permit for the Compressor Station** planned for Northampton County: DEQ recently received the air quality modelling from ACP, but has not specified whether they consider the application complete. Once complete, DEQ has only 10 days to decide whether to approve the permit.
- **The Stormwater (Polluted Runoff) Permits** for the northern and southern sections of the ACP; these permits were only recently submitted to DEQ.
